Thank you for submitting your Electronic Waste Recycler registration form to the Michigan Department of Natural Resources and Environment (DNRE) as required by [Part 173](#), Electronics, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended. This letter is to acknowledge receipt of your administratively complete registration form.


A list of registered manufacturers and recyclers and their administratively complete registrations can be viewed by navigating to www.michigan.gov/deqewaste and clicking on the [Electronic Waste Takeback Program](#).

In addition to submitting the registration form to the DNRE and paying the \$2,000 annual registration fee, Electronic Waste Recyclers must comply with the requirements of Part 173, including:

1. Recyclers must recycle the devices in a manner that complies with federal and state laws and local ordinances. [Section 17315(1)]
2. Beginning October 30, 2010, a recycler of covered electronic devices shall report the total weight of covered electronic devices recycled during the previous year. The recycler shall keep a written log that records the weight of covered video display devices and the total weight of covered computers delivered to the recycler and identified as such on receipt. The total weight reported in the registration shall be based on this log.
3. Manufacturers must accept up to seven covered electronic devices from a single consumer in a single day through their takeback program. [Section 17309(2)]
